Tell an adult I trust straight away

What should I do if people are mean to me online or if I am worried about them?

Try to stay calm

Report anything that worries me

Try to ignore the person

Block and delete the person

Keep all messages for proof

REMEMBER: STOP! BLOCK! TELL!

What should I not do?

Do not keep worries to yourself

Do not be unkind or nasty back

Do not get angry or upset

Do not allow the person to keep being unkind

Do not delete messages

We investigate and look at evidence

We make sure children face up to their actions

We contact parents and carers and other adults
