



The Friars Primary School provides Spanish language learning in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6. Each class has 30 minutes of MFL teaching a week. This may be split into two 15 minute sessions, or short sections of learning over the week.

A variety of language teaching methods are used to match groups and individuals with different learning styles, these include games, role-play, use of a range of media and songs.

The lessons are made as entertaining and enjoyable as possible, as we realise that this approach serves to develop a positive attitude in the children to the learning of modern foreign languages.

At The Friars Primary School, there is a clear progression of skills and understanding that builds through Key Stage based on the National Curriculum Programme of Study.

Teachers plan sessions with access to the Salford Scheme of Work, which supports staff in ensuring that their delivery of Spanish is accurate, even if they are not a Spanish speaker themselves.

This planning takes account of prior learning and builds on this. Powerpoints and lesson plans are provided as part of the Salford Scheme.
